

# **2023 / 2024 Crookwell Summer Soccer**

Mixed 5-a-side competition for all ages over 13 (If you are 12yo and played in the STFA Senior Winter competition you are eligible to play)

**Venue:** Lin Cooper Fields, Junior Grounds

## **Competition Dates:**

Monday 13 November 2023 to & inc Monday 18 December 2023

Games resume after school holidays

Monday 29 January 2024 to & inc Monday 18 March (including finals) 2024

**Time Slots:** 5:45pm & 6:30pm (20 minute halves)

**Registration:** Registrations close Monday 6th November 2023.

**Cost:** \$180.00 per team. This fee will cover the insurance and the player fees for a maximum of 9 players. Additional players over 9 cost \$20 each.

## **Basics:**

- Minimum of 5 players per team
- 2 females required on the field at all times
- All team players are to wear the same coloured t-shirts
- It is at the Crookwell Soccer Club's discretion how many teams are accepted into the competition. The first 16 teams to be registered will be guaranteed. This competition cannot host more than 20 teams.
- Each team will be rostered on to referee a game prior or after their match.
- *This season, each timeslot will be split into two divisions after approximately 7 games.*

## **To complete your team registration:**

- Complete a team registration form; signatures of all players/guardians are required.
- The team registration fee of \$180.00 must be paid in full. No part payments will be accepted.
- The form and monies must be received on or prior to Monday 6th November 2023.
