Net Roster

NET duty is at **8.30am** and entails putting up the nets on all fields. Nets can be found in the Otto bins in the storage shed next to the tennis courts.

At the end of games, please take the nets down and put into the Otto bins and put all equipment back into the storage shed.

Canteen

CANTEEN DUTY is from **8.30 am** to approximately 11.15am.

Your duties are to help set up the canteen, heat pies etc, serve the customers and restock, clean up / wash up as needed.

A full duties list is posted in the Canteen.

Barbeque

Start cooking at **8.45am**:

Wheel BBQ out to side of Canteen and clean the BBQ plate.

Cook required meat, eggs and onions etc., put onto trays.

Put trays into pie warmers.

Clean BBQ and empty grease bucket (when safe to do so).

Put BBQ back into storage room.

The Barbeque may not be conducted every week.

Children are required to wear black shorts and socks. (Black track pants are permitted in cold weather.)

Soccer shirts will be distributed and collected by team coaches each week.

All players in A, B, C and D Grades must wear covered shoes.

Shin pads **MUST** be worn **UNDER** socks in all grades.

Game duration times:

A Grade will have two halves of 25 minutes each half.

B Grade will have two halves of 20 minutes each half.

C and D Grades will have two halves of 15 minutes each half.

All Grades will have a 5 minute break between each half.
